

## Meeting 17

- Before the Meeting
  - Remind group to read and work through Step 4 of Meeting 17 (pg 97-101).
  - As you read through Step 4 initially on your own, highlight what sticks out to you and write down questions you want to discuss with the group. Bring up these observations and questions to the group.
- Step 3
  - Don't neglect this! Hopefully your whole group is able to say their story easily. Challenge them to practice if they don't have it down.
- Step 4
  - Don't just read through this. Bring up your questions and what stuck out to you as you work through this (see 2<sup>nd</sup> bullet under Before the Meeting). For each section, I recommend this game plan (*questions to ask are in italics*):
    - **Multiply: a Biblical Mandate**
      - *Had you ever connected the dots between Genesis 1 and the Great Commission? What do you think about this?*
      - *What is your strategy for building God's kingdom?*
      - *Why don't many churches today have a multiplication mindset?*
    - **Two Reasons Why**
      - *What stuck out to you most about these two reasons?*
      - *What do you think about this argument for multiplication?*
    - **Swimming in the Deep End**
      - Work through the three questions given in this section.
    - **The Motivation to Multiply**
      - If time allows, read through this paragraph again.
      - Work through the two questions given in this section.
    - **Life on Mission**
      - If time allows, read this paragraph again.
- Step 5
  - Part 1
    - How you pair up is not set in stone here. Get a plan on paper knowing that you can revise it as necessary.
  - Part 2
    - Everyone needs to write down at least one name. Commit to praying for the next generation of disciple-makers.
  - Part 3
    - At this point you will start (if you haven't already) rotating who facilitates the meeting.
    - Make group aware of these facilitator guides if they don't know yet.
    - If you are already rotating leaders, **I would come up with another GO**. It can be over anything. Maybe retry something you were red light on in a previous meeting.
