Discussion time will be limited this meeting because we will be developing a Crossroad Map on the next page. Take 10 minutes to discuss some of the questions online.

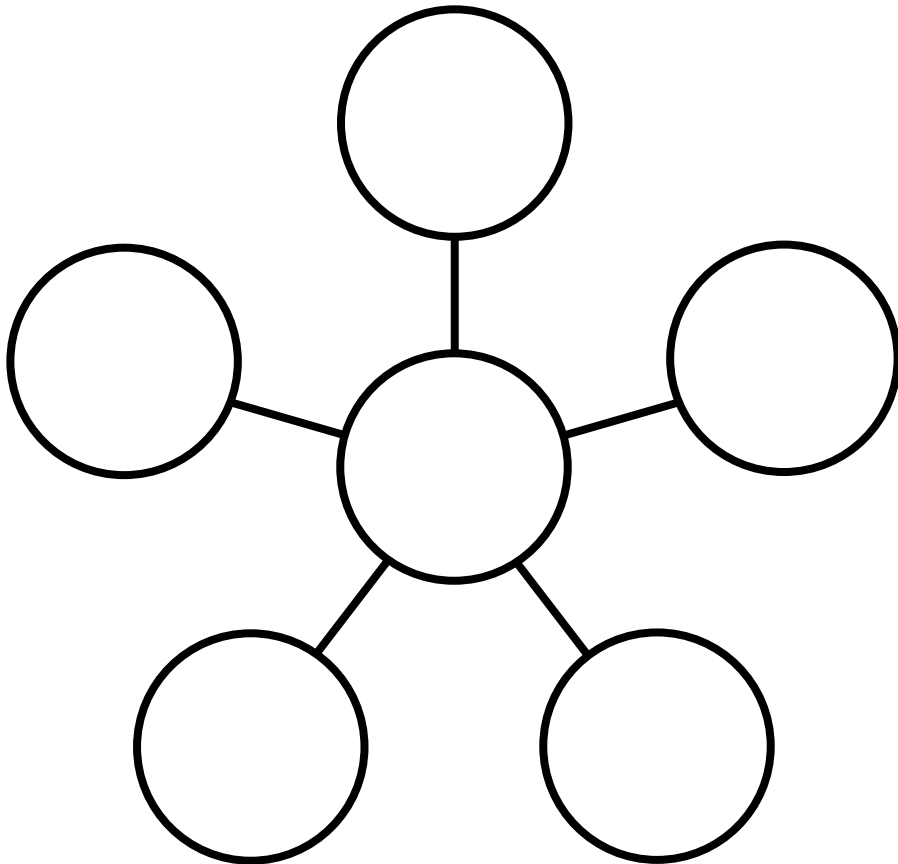


There are tools made available to you online for each mission measure. Navigate through them to see if any would be helpful to you, namely the Example GO’s.

step 4

MAKING A CROSSROAD MAP

Christ commanded all believers to go out and make disciples of all nations. You are a believer. Therefore, you must take the gospel to unbelievers. If we aren’t intentionally praying for, serving, and sharing the gospel with the lost, then we are missing out on an opportunity to participate in God’s plan. You made some great headway last meeting by determining your Crossroad(s). But we minister to people, not a location. So, who are the specific nonbelievers in your Crossroad(s) that you are seeking (in the Spirit’s power) to make disciples out of? A Crossroad Map is a simple tool that will help us fully answer this question. Below the discussion questions for this meeting’s online material, there is a video explaining how to make a Crossroads Map. Watch it as a group and then make yours in the space below.



The 5 (or more) people connected to you on your Crossroad Map will be your focus for the rest of this GO Group. You will be praying for them, serving them, and hopefully sharing the gospel with them before your group finishes. How amazing would it be if one of them came to faith and was in your next GO Group because you lived on mission? In Meeting 9, the majority of the meeting will be spent praying together for these people. How awesome is that?! So you can do this well, your GO between now and Meeting 10 is to gather prayer requests from them. This is everyone's GO. **To be clear, you are only seeking prayer requests from the people connected to you**, not any of the other generations. Write these prayer requests down in the appropriate space in Step 4 of Meeting 9 (page 64), which is part of your assignment for next week.

Asking for prayer requests might feel like an awkward task. This is why it's called a GO. If you are unsure of how to go about this, say something like:

"Hey, a group from my church is spending some time in prayer next week. We are praying for people that matter to us, so I wanted to see if there is anything going on in your life that I can pray for."

I call this Care through Prayer. You will be surprised how open people are to the idea of you praying for them. Be in prayer for one another as you reach out. Who knows what God might do. Determine how and when you will gather prayer requests from the people connected to you in your Crossroad Map below.
