## Meeting 2

- Before the Meeting
  - Text your group and have them download the FBCR App beforehand.
- Step 2
  - This is the first of many times you will be prompted to access the online material to guide your discussion.
  - You will want to do two things:
    - Show them how to access the material (online or in the FBCR App).
    - Show them what resources are available.
  - Website Consists of 4 Parts
    - Video
      - You'll watch this video in your group the first time because they need to learn how to navigate the material.
    - Discussion Questions
      - This isn't an assignment. Don't feel the need to get through all of them. It's better to go deep with just 1 question than to rush through all of them.
      - Questions 1, 2, & 4 are my favorite. If I don't have time for all 5, I'm focusing on these 3.
      - Be the first to be honest. They will follow your lead.
        - Everyone struggles. We are all sinners. Let's not pretend we are someone we aren't. Set the tone by being honest first.
    - Bible Backing
      - If you want work through the Biblical backing, you can. But remember you need to save about 15 minutes for GO time.
      - Read the verses and simply ask, "Did anything stick out to you?"
    - Tools
      - Tell them there are extra resources for you to look into for each meeting.
      - Example GOs can be super helpful.
        - You can use these if you get stuck on coming up with a GO to take.
    - Show them Important Features
      - Forgot your book (top right corner).
- Step 3
  - $\circ$   $\;$  This is the first time you will Pledge to take a Risk as GO Group.
  - Follow the instructions and use the Example Risks and the Risk Suggestion in the top right corner of page 8 if you get stuck.
- Next Meeting Objectives
  - Read the paragraph.
  - Make sure you let them know they need to complete Step 3 of Meeting 3 before next time. Meeting 3 won't work if everyone doesn't do this.
    - Step 3 is called the Life-Line exercise. It's a way to share your testimony in 5 minutes.
    - It's powerful!!! Make sure your group comes prepared.
- After the meeting
  - Because I am forgetful, I always set a reminder on my phone to check-in with the group on how they are doing with their goal.
  - $\circ$   $\;$  You can group text/email, or you can check in individually.
  - It's not a bad idea to give your people a call every once in a while.
  - The more you relationally invest as a leader, the better chance of success your group will have!
